All but one of the policy submittals from Illinois were approved by delegates at the American Farm Bureau Federation Annual Convention, including our urban ag policy. We also successfully added policy to the livestock, renewable energy, and broadband sections.

IFB received a New Horizon Award in recognition of its efforts on mental health. The award, recognizing new innovative state Farm Bureau programs, stemmed from IFB's one-day Illinois Ag Mental Health Summit in March and its collection of mental health resources. Three Illinois county Farm Bureaus received Activities of Excellence Awards.

IFB members have submitted over 1,600 comments to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, opposing the repeal of the Navigable Water Protection Rule. The action request will be live until the comment period closes on February 7.

A California court ruling delayed enforcement of Proposition 12, highlighting the inherent flaws of the rule. AFBF and the National Pork Producers Association have asked the U.S. Supreme Court to consider the case.
